For 60-minute and 90-minute debates, only Members on the call list will be called to speak, and they will be called in the order they appear on the call list, subject to discretion of the Chair.

Members who are not on the call list are not permitted to attend debates.

For 30-minute debates, there will not be a call list. Members may attend to intervene or make a short speech. Members wishing to make a speech should follow existing conventions about contacting the Member in charge of the debate, the Speaker's Office ([speakersoffice@parliament.uk](mailto:speakersoffice@parliament.uk)) and the Minister.
